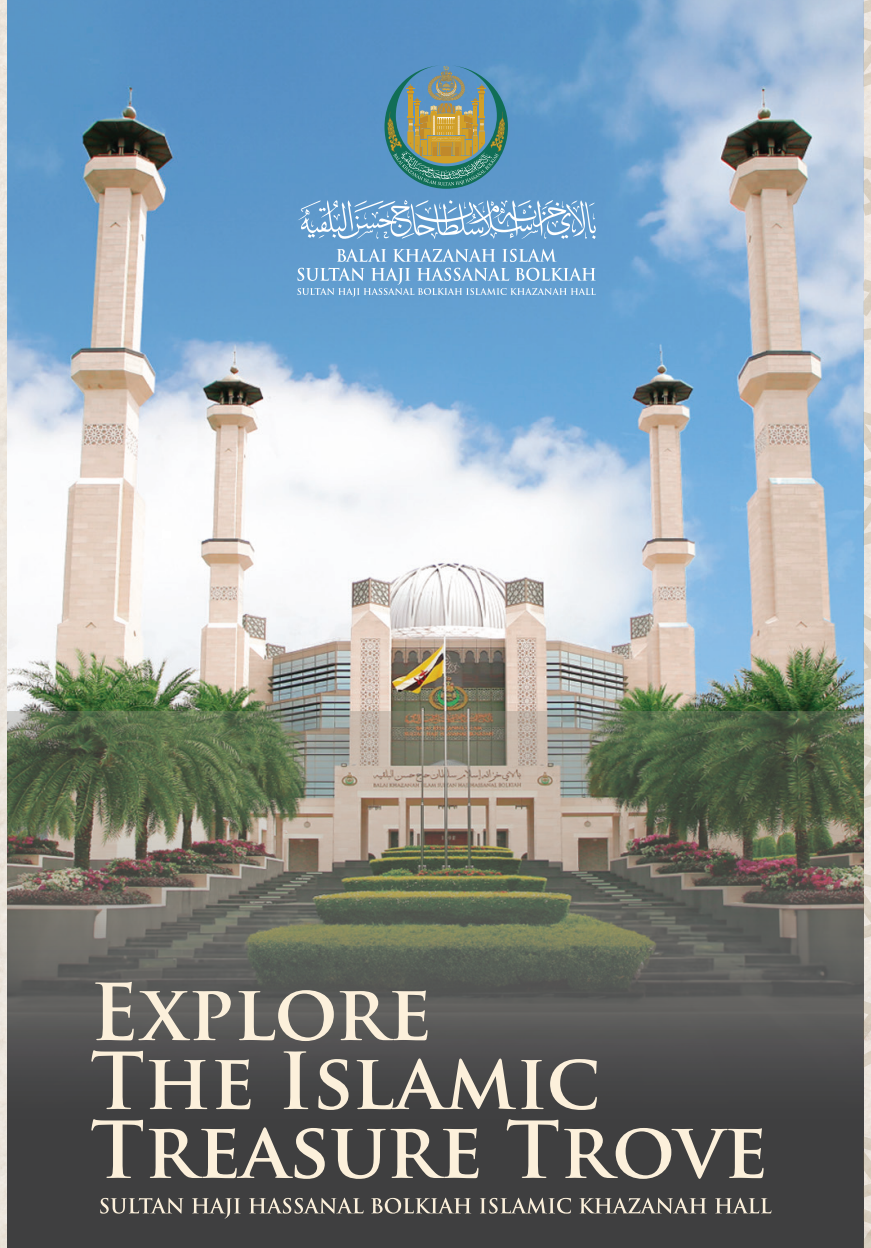
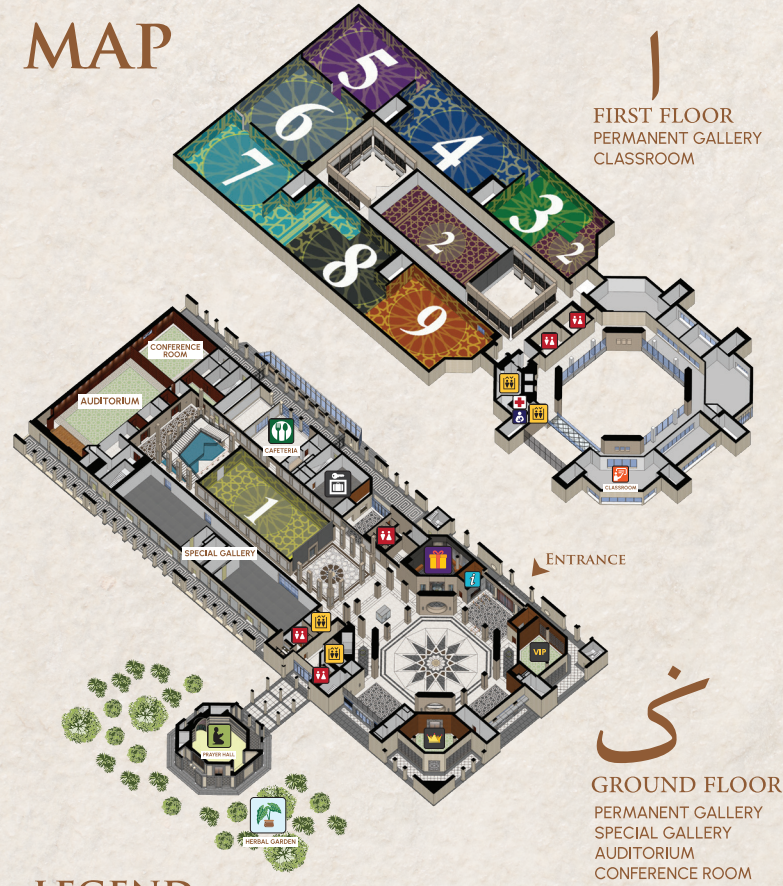

INTRODUCTION

Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah Islamic Khazanah Hall, a majestic and modern iconic Islamic architecture designed by renowned PEI Architects, built on one of the highest points of Bandar Seri Begawan and located at Jalan Pengiran Babu Raja, about 3 km from the city centre, was inaugurated and officially opened by His Majesty Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah Mu'izzaddin Waddaulah, the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam on 13 Safar 1441 corresponding to 12 October 2019.

The Islamic Khazanah Hall is a manifestation of the intellectual leadership of His Majesty the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam in maintaining, empowering and preserving Islamic civilisation and culture as well as promoting Islamic knowledge and heritage globally. It has nine (9) permanent galleries that exhibit His Majesty's extensive personal Islamic treasures collection encompassing artefacts such as Qur'anic Mushafs, Arabic, Persian and Malay manuscripts, prayer beads, walking sticks, fossils, ancient Islamic astronomical instruments, as well as the Noble Hair of the Prophet ﷺ, a fragment of the cloak of the Prophet ﷺ, replicas of the Prophet and his companions' swords, and much more. The Islamic Khazanah Hall also has a number of world class standard facilities including auditorium, conference room, meeting room, VIP lounge, conservation lab and prayer hall, among others. The magnificent architecture and the Islamic treasure trove also aim to make the landmark as a one stop Islamic tourism destination.

EXHIBITION GALLERIES

GALLERY 1: KING'S WISDOM

This gallery focuses on the leadership, personality and intellectualism of His Majesty Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah Mu'izzaddin Waddaulah, the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam particularly from the Islamic perspective. Among the collections displayed are published books that are part of the personal collections of His Majesty Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah Mu'izzaddin Waddaulah, the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam, *Hukum Kanun Brunei* (Canon Law of Brunei), Mushaf Brunei Darussalam and His Majesty's cloak after performing the Haji.



GALLERY 2: MUSHAF

This gallery displays the personal collection of Mushaf of His Majesty Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah Mu'izzaddin Waddaulah, the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam in its own distinct form, colour and writing technique originating from Malaysia, Indonesia, Iran, Türkiye, Spain, India and others.

GALLERY 3: THE NOBLE HAIR OF THE PROPHET ﷺ

This gallery displays the noble hair of the Prophet ﷺ along with other collections such as a fragment of *burdah* (cloak), swords, footprint, slippers and a walking stick of the Prophet ﷺ.



GALLERY 4: VESTIGES OF THE COMPANIONS

This gallery displays vestiges belonging to the Companions of The Prophet ﷺ such as a replica of 'Uthmani Al-Qur'an, swords, hair and beard of the companions and grandsons of the Prophet ﷺ.

GALLERY 5: KNOWLEDGE HERITAGE I

This gallery displays a coinage collection and Islamic manuscript belonging to His Majesty Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah Mu'izzaddin Waddaulah, the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam in various religious fields in Arabic, Persian and Malay (Jawi).



GALLERY 6: KNOWLEDGE HERITAGE II

This gallery displays *kiswah* Ka'abah (ornate brocade cloth) as the main highlight which is closely linked to the Hajji pilgrimage (fifth pillar of Islam). This gallery also displays a curtain from the tomb of the Prophet ﷺ.



GALLERY 7: SIGNS OF THE GREATNESS OF ALLAH ﷻ

This gallery exhibits collection of flora and fauna fossils that demonstrate the greatness of Allah ﷻ. The fauna fossils consist of Lycopteridae (fish), Pinnidae (shells), Mollusca (snails), Galenidae (crabs), corals and more. Meanwhile, the flora fossils exhibited in this gallery are seeds, leaves and tree trunks from the Neogene period. Some of the fossils were discovered in Brunei Darussalam.

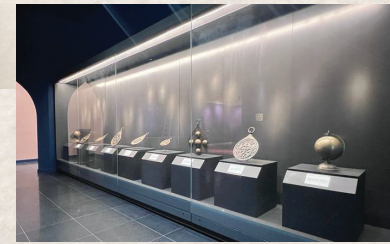

GALLERY 8: ASTRONOMY

This gallery exhibits tools which were used by the Islamic scholars in the field of astronomy such as astrolabe, quadrant, compass, rain gauge, celestial globe and telescope.



GALLERY 9: ISLAMIC ART, WALKING STICKS & PRAYER BEADS

This gallery exhibits Islamic arts such as calligraphy, qur'an stands, architecture and ceramics. This gallery also showcases personal collections of His Majesty Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah Mu'izzaddin Waddaulah, the Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam comprising of walking sticks and prayer beads.

HERBAL GARDEN

The Herbal Garden at the Islamic Khazanah Hall is a thoughtfully curated green space dedicated to showcasing medicinal and culinary plants referenced in Islamic tradition. The garden serves both educational and spiritual purposes, offering visitors a deeper understanding of the natural remedies and botanical knowledge found in Islamic heritage.
